

**YOU'RE = YOU ARE**

Part of Speech:  
**CONTRACTION**

**Definition:**  
A combination of the pronoun "YOU" and the verb "ARE".

**TIP:**  
Could you substitute "you are" in your sentence?

**Example:**  
You're doing such a wonderful job!  
  
I can't tell if you're kidding or not.

**"YOU ARE"**

When **YOU'RE** a Fourth Grader, you learn correct grammar by listening to **YOUR** teacher!

What is  favorite subject?

my best friend.

Let me know if  going to the game.

When is  birthday?

When  hungry,  stomach growls.

**YOU'RE** **YOUR** **YOU'RE** **YOUR**  
**YOU'RE** **YOUR** **YOUR** **YOU'RE**

**YOUR = Belongs to YOU**

Part of Speech:  
**ADJECTIVE**

**Definition:**  
Of or relating to you or yourself; reflects ownership.

**TIP:**  
Could you substitute "my" in your sentence?

**Example:**  
Did the dog eat your homework?

Your birthday party was really fun!

**DOES "MY" FIT?**
