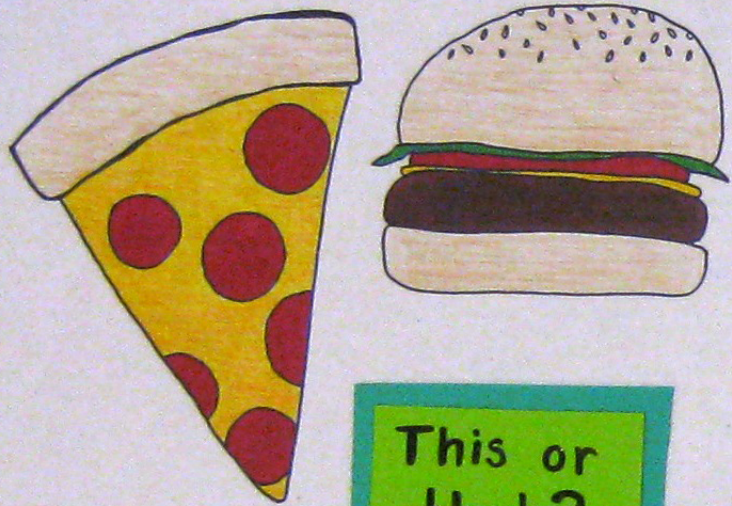


# THEN or THAN?
