

<u>Exam Master</u>\*, available from the library under Search – Databases – "E", is an efficient way for Dentistry, Medicine, Pharmacy, and Physician Assistant students to study for the NBDE, USMLE, NAPLEX, and PANCE board exams, and to review medical subjects. Beginning July 2019, NCLEX Nursing study materials will also be available. \*New users need to create an account with their UNE email address.

Library Services has review resources for all graduate students in the form of <u>review books</u> and also offers several subject databases which include review questions (e.g. <u>AccessMedicine</u> and <u>PharmacyLibrary</u>). Ask us for help locating these resources!

Undergraduates aiming for graduate study will find preparation tools for graduate admissions in <a href="LearningExpress Library"><u>LearningExpress Library</u></a> (under "College Students"). Available resources include GMAT, GRE, LSAT, MAT, MCAT, and PCAT ebooks and practice tests.
