<u>Westbrook College History Collection</u> – 1842-1996: Administrative records, student scrapbooks, photos, audio-visual materials, and artifacts of Westbrook College history until its merger with UNE in 1996.

<u>St. Francis College History Collection</u> – 1818-1980: Administrative records, artifacts, scrapbooks, audiovisual materials documenting St. Francis College and the history of the Biddeford Campus.

<u>Maine Women Writers Collection</u> – 18th century to the present: Published and unpublished literary, cultural, and social history sources by and about Maine women.

<u>New England Osteopathic Heritage Center</u> – 1896-2010: Photographs, audio-visual materials, and paper records documenting the history of the Osteopathic profession in New England.

<u>Bush Legacy Collection</u>: Randall J. Cushing collection of World War I and II Letters, and artifacts donated by George and Barbara Bush.

<u>UNE Art Galleries' Permanent Collection</u> – 1978 to the present: Over 500 works of art; especially strong in photography; includes prints, paintings, drawings, sculptures held and shown on the PC and BC.
